**Ramadhan 2017**

As many of you will be aware, Ramadhan is due to start at the beginning of the half term break (approximately 27th May 2017) and will run for approximately one month, ending around Sunday 25th June 2017.

**Please note that, the school will be closed for students on Monday 26th June 2017 and Tuesday 27th June 2017, but will be open for those students who have exams on these days.**

**When students come to school on Wednesday 28th June 2017, they are welcome to wear Non - School Uniform.**

During Ramadhan, the school day will run as normal, with the exception that we will only have one lunchtime, at 1.00pm where anyone requiring a lunch will be able to access one. Students who are eligible for free school meals will be able to collect a 'grab bag' to take home with them at the end of the school day.

Our Year 11 and UAK6 students who have exams after half term, will also have the opportunity to eat before their exams at 12.00pm, should they wish to.

We will also be providing additional prayer room facilities during break times, should students wish to use these.

Whilst we appreciate that it can be a challenging period for all students and staff observing the fast, particularly during the summer months, we still expect 100% attendance from all our students and for them to be on time for school.
